

Monrovia Reads Projects

Read Across Monrovia

- Community volunteers read to children at all the local public elementary schools in Monrovia.



- The read-ins are held in March and October.

New Book Distribution

- Distributed primarily to families with children in lower socio-economic status because many of these homes have little or no reading material.
- Books are distributed at Unity Foothill and City events.



Book Set Mini-Grants

- Class sets are given to classes at the middle schools and high school.
- Books are literature selected by teachers when lack of funding in the school budget prevents purchase.
- Students keep their own paperback for their personal libraries.

- Mobile Literacy and Recreation program

- Tutoring and homework help

Pro-Active Tutoring (PAT)

- Assists K - 12 students at Monrovia public schools.
- Tutors are local college students in work-study programs and community volunteers.

Library Literacy Services

- One-to-one, free tutoring for adults and children.
- Learners work individually with trained volunteer tutors.
- Materials and on-going support are provided by the Library.



Story Time

- Filmed group story time, introducing exciting reading themes and challenging concepts to young readers.
